Survey conducted in January 2020 among 172 graduates (from the 2007-2009 class to the 2018-2020 class).








The Key Numbers

Where students come from?






European and Asian students are mainly students of initial training and students from Africa and Latin America are of professional origin.


TPTI and then after?
